2. Explanation

Do:

In this activity the goal is to recognize how holiday planning affect the environment and people. In addition this activity will enable participants to understand how international borders and nationalities operate.

The activity takes into account the following topics::

- Sustainable Tourism
- Consuming national products.
- Border controls
- Racism
- Co2 footprint
- Transportation means

Step 1: Divide participants in small groups (according to the number of participants).

Step 2: The different participants choose a nationality from a list of available nationalities (developed countries and developing countries, find in the attached document). The participants make their passport with the delivered materials.

Step 3: The participants start planning a holiday together. They have to choose a destination, transportation, accommodation, food and activities.

Step 4: The participants leave for a holiday. Before they leave they have to go through a "security control" simulating an airport where they will be treated differently according to their nationality (the facilitator will be in charge of simulating the security control).

Step 5: Transportation. To get to the destination they have different options, this can be adapted according to what you have available. Ex: If you fly you make an airplane out of a piece of paper and throw it to the destination. You only have one throw because planes do not represent renewable energy. In this step be creative to find representative ways of transportation.

Step 6: Arrival to the destination airport where the participants go through customs. Once again they are treated according to their nationalities and some of them will be denied entry to the country. In that case, the group has to go back and do everything again with a new destination where everyone is able to go without a visa.

The activity will end when everyone can enter to a country. After this, the participants will go to the debriefing.
