

<p>Asylum Seeker</p>	<p>A person who has made an application for asylum and is waiting to hear the decision on their application.</p>
<p>Refugee camp</p>	<p>Settlement where refugees live while they wait to find a new home. They lack basic services such as schools, sanitation and medical facilities, and although they are supposed to temporary, many end up living here for years, sometimes their whole lives.</p>
<p>Refugee</p>	<p>Someone who has had to flee from their own country because of conflict, discrimination, poverty or other human rights abuses.</p>
<p>Internally displaced persons (IDPs)</p>	<p>People who are forced to flee their homes but remain within their country's borders.</p>
<p>People smugglers</p>	<p>Someone who works with the illegal transportation of people from one country to another. They often exploit refugees and migrants, who are desperate to get to another country, by demanding extremely high prices or even robbing and abusing the people they are transporting.</p>

<p>Detention Centres</p>	<p>A place where refugees, migrants or asylum seekers are kept, without opportunities to leave, usually waiting to be deported.</p>
